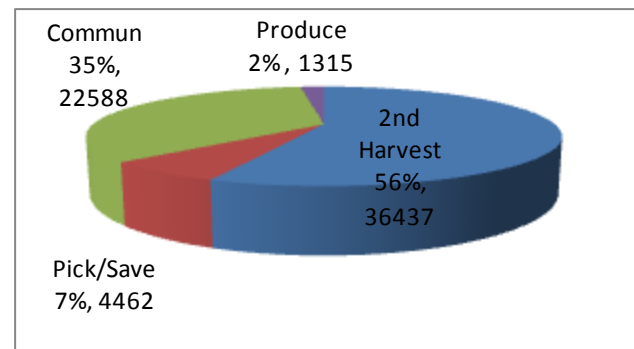
Simply put, over 32 Tons of food was distributed in 2009 and in 2010 this will rise.
